

BRITAIN'S GOT TALENT SUPERSTAR

Ridgeway High School student Chelsea Evans, who is in Year 10, appeared on ITV's *Britain's Got Talent: The Champions* on Saturday 7 September, winning through to the final as part of the MerseyGirls dance group.
